

EN ROUTE ABOARD THE MS PRIMADONNA

The service times for the **breakfast buffet, lunch and dinner** are flexible depending on the route's timetable; you can find the times in the info sheet "MS Primadonna today" (displayed opposite the reception). You can come whenever you prefer during the listed times (no set beginning). If you are on a **special diet** or have any **nutritional restrictions**, please let us know one week in advance at the latest so that we can best accommodate you.

**Your table at the restaurant** is identified by your cabin number. Our service chef accepts your preferences on the day of arrival.

Please sign the **bill for your drinks** before you leave the restaurant/bar! - Please note that drinks cannot be paid in cash at the restaurant/bar. Please **pay for your drinks, excursions, etc.** on the last night after 8.30 pm or on the last day after 7 am. If you

consume any drinks from the **minibar** in your cabin, please let the reception desk know BEFORE dinner on the second last day otherwise you automatically accept the declaration of the cabin staff. Possible methods of payment: cash, cash machine and credit card (ONLY Mastercard & Visa).

**W-Lan/Wi-Fi is free** in the entire atrium. During the way as well as at watergates dead spots can occur. Current voltage is 220 volts. **Pets** are forbidden.

During some cruises we have a masseur and a hairdresser on board.

**Additional massages/beard shaves** can be ordered at the reception for a surcharge.

As listed in the daily program, there is a **film showing** in Primo Teatro in the late evening, free of charge.

Please deposit your labelled luggage at the **landing stage** in the Prima Vista. We will transport it quickly to your cabin. Please fill out the attached customer sheet fully and bring it to the check-in (= preferred boarding).

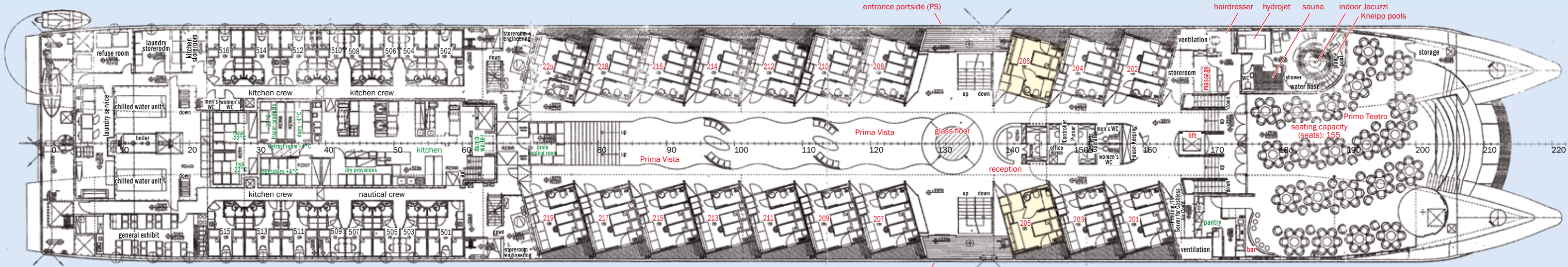
At **disembarkation**, leave your labelled luggage in front of your cabin door 30 minutes before arrival.

During bike & boat tours: Your own/rented bikes must only be taken on/ from board by our crew!

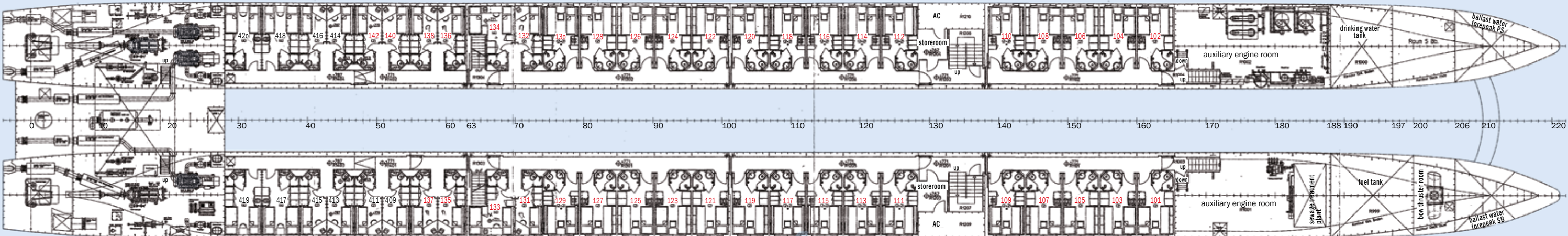

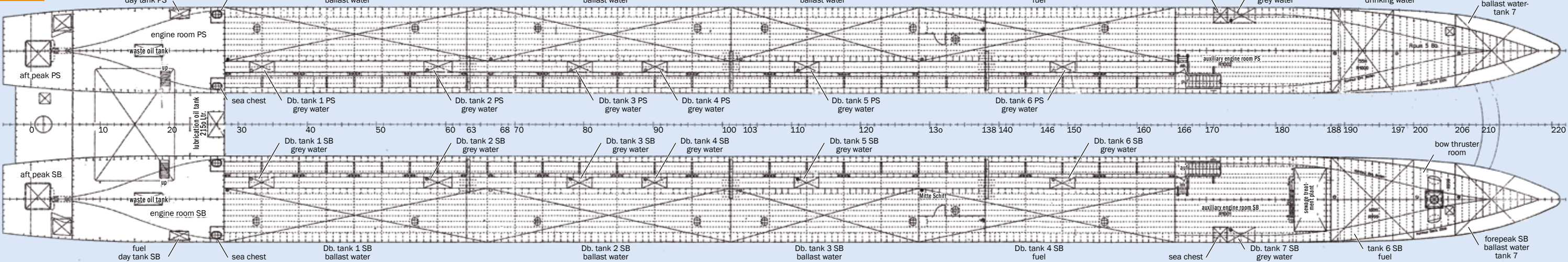
02 | Upper deck

00 | Lower deck



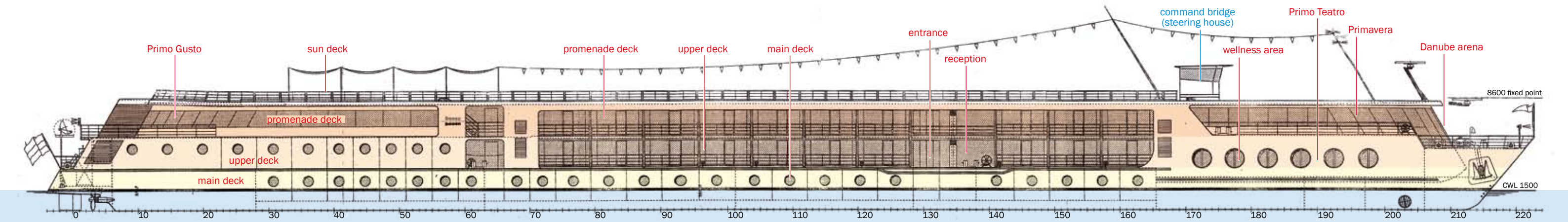

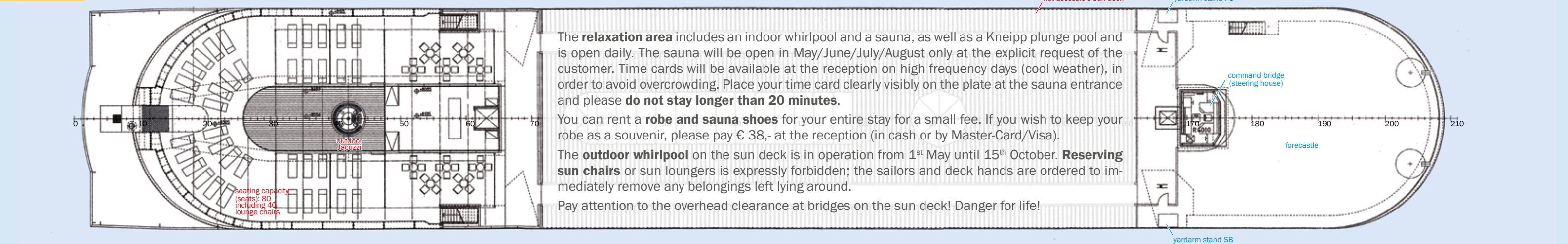

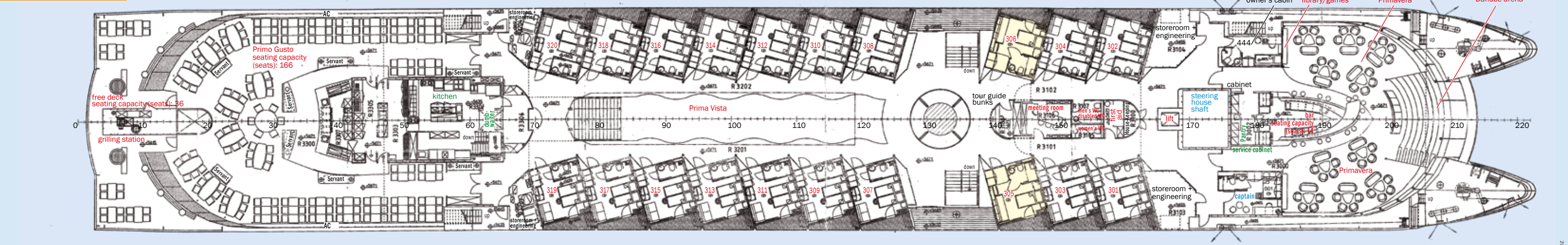

The ship was built by Deggendorfer Werft. The christening was undertaken by **Christiane Herzog**, the wife of the former president of Germany. The draft, concept and design were developed by the planning group Deas. The contracting entity and first owner was Conti Flussschiffahrts-GmbH & Co KG, which chartered the ship to the Delphin See- und Flusstouristik GmbH, which ended the charter at the end of 2000. The ship was run under the name **Primadonna** for Viking River Cruises

from **2001** to 2013. From 2013 to July 2015 the operator was Nicko Tours. In July 2015 Donau Touristik GmbH in Linz, Austria, purchased this **unique catamaran river cruise ship in the world**. The navigated area of the Primadonna is the Danube River from Passau to Budapest as well as the Danube Delta.

**Special characteristics:** The Primadonna's chosen twin-hulled model makes it a unique river cruise ship. The ship is the most expensive passenger ship in existence on the Danube (78.5 million DM = 40.1 million €).

**Equipment:** The ship has 81 cabins for up to 198 guests and 27 crew cabins. The promenade and upper decks each contain 20 passenger cabins with balconies. A further 41 slightly smaller cabins are available on the main deck.
